

# GET FINANCIAL HELP

## for your health coverage

We're here to help you figure out what kind of financial help you might qualify for. People in one household may qualify for different programs. This guide does not guarantee you qualify for financial help. Find out exactly what you qualify for by completing an application.

**STEP 1** Figure out **how many people** are on your federal income tax return with you (this is your **family size**).

**STEP 2** Add up your family's gross **monthly income**.

**STEP 3** Use **Chart A** to see if you qualify for free or low-cost health coverage through Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program) or the Child Health Plan *Plus* (CHP+) program.

Apply for these programs, and learn the full qualifications for Medicaid programs, at [Colorado.gov/PEAK](http://Colorado.gov/PEAK). If you make **more than** the amount shown for your family size, check if you might qualify for financial help through Connect for Health Colorado.

**STEP 4** Estimate your **annual** adjusted gross income.

**STEP 5** Use **Chart B** to see if you might qualify for lower monthly costs (Advance Premium Tax Credits) and health care discounts (Cost-Sharing Reductions) on a private health insurance plan through Connect for Health Colorado.
